



Smoking

You may not smoke (tobacco or any other substance) anywhere within the Lodge. This is for both reasons of safety (the dry mountain air makes buildings exceptionally prone to fire) and for the comfort and health of other occupants. If you ignore this rule, you cannot expect to stay in the Lodge again.

Children

Parents are responsible for children and should ensure they do not become a nuisance to others.

Boots

Take your ski boots (or any other heavy soled boots) off in the ski room and leave them there or on pegs in the drying room. New carpets cost money.

Plumbing

Food particles and tea leaves are a menace. Use tea bags and dispose of these and any food scraps in the garbage bin. The strainers in the kitchen sinks are there to prevent the grease trap from becoming clogged. If it does, you may be the one who has to dig it out. Tampons/sanitary pads must not be flushed down the toilet.

Electricity

You may use a hair dryer, rollers, or an electric razor, but other personal appliances can be a fire hazard. Please leave them at home.

Beds

You must use a pillow case and either sheets or a sleeping bag. Bed linen is supplied during winter.

Touring

Cross-country skiers should enter the time of departure, destination and estimated time of return, in the Lodge touring register so that we have some idea where to send the search and rescue team.

Barbecue

The barbecue is secured to the deck and is to be operated in this position, covered and tied down during inclement weather. To operate, push knobs in and then turn. Turn OFF the gas cock at the wall when not in use. Drain tray must be emptied at least weekly or more frequently if necessary. Ceramic tiles located under the open grill to be turned over weekly.

Room Heating

The only control you need to be concerned with is the thermostat on the radiator in your room, set to your comfort (max 20 deg C). Suggest 13 to 15 deg C during the night to prevent throat drying out. Please ensure that power is not wasted in unoccupied rooms. The heater in the locker room is to be left ON at all times. This is to keep the rear wall of the lodge warm and prevent the snow pushing the lodge down the hill.

End of Stay

Winter changeover is at 10:00am on Saturday. If we have cleaners on Saturday morning, the kitchen is to be vacated by 8:00am and the bathrooms by 9:00am. If you prevent the cleaners from doing their jobs, these jobs then become your jobs. Please keep the Lodge as you would wish to find it.
